PLANNED PARENTHOOD AND THE CULTURE OF DEATH

Planned Parenthood is to the culture of death what Microsoft is to computer software. With its huge financial empire, Planned Parenthood permeates the planet with its deadly philosophy.

With money from the U.S. foreign aid program, the United Nations, and the wealthiest foundations, Planned Parenthood undermines the laws and cultures of developing countries in order to make them conform to its own anti-human vision. At the same time, Planned Parenthood convinces those in the Western World that the planet cannot survive without population control achieved by almost any means.

In the United States, Planned Parenthood is the behemoth of the abortion industry. In its own facilities, Planned Parenthood killed 153,367 children in 1996 and, with but two exceptions, has increased both its volume and market share in killing for hire every year. In fact, Planned Parenthood actively seeks to do so.

Planned Parenthood carries on the largest and most effective market promotion plan in the abortion industry through its distribution of sex aids to children. Hundreds of thousands of young girls are enticed by Planned Parenthood's so-called educational, counseling and "family planning" programs into performing sex acts—in many cases becoming victims of statutory rape.

Every year, a certain proportion of these exploited girls go back to Planned Parenthood as customers. What's more, Planned Parenthood gets the federal

and state governments to pay for its child exploitation activities, an achievement the common pimp on the street has yet to realize.

All of this says nothing about what Planned Parenthood teaches children, often behind the backs of parents. *Boys and Sex*, by Wardell B. Pomeroy, Ph.D. (who also authored *Girls and Sex*), a book recommended by Planned Parenthood and written for teenagers, suggests that children who practice bestiality should simply keep it a secret. The question and answer part of the book includes the following text:

What would happen if a boy had intercourse with an animal?

Among boys who practice it, intercourse with animals is usually infrequent, but there are case histories of boys who build up a strong emotional attachment to a particular animal and have intercourse with it whenever possible. This behavior is against the law in every state. There are severe penalties for violations, and social ridicule accompanies discovery. Nevertheless, records of such cases can be found in our history from colonial days to the present...

This kind of sexual behavior may never happen to you, because the incidence is so low. If it does, you would be best advised to keep any knowledge of it to yourself so you can avoid either ridicule or punishment, or both. You can feel secure in your knowledge that you're not a monster, no matter what society may think about it.

As to whether bestiality is immoral or not, Pomeroy writes, "that depends entirely on the point of view." Pomeroy also discusses other forms of sodomy, prostitution, sadomasochism, homosexuality and so forth. Needless-to-say, most parents would be appalled if they were to learn that

Planned Parenthood had placed this book in the hands of their children.

The Planned Parenthood pamphlet “You’ve Changed the Combination!!!,” tells teenagers, “There are only two basic kinds of sex: sex with victims and sex without. Sex with victims is always wrong. Sex without is always right.”

This is only the beginning, but the point is clear. Planned Parenthood is far out of step with the views of most Americans when it comes to sexual morals. Yet it uses taxpayer dollars to spread its horrific message to the most vulnerable and innocent among us.

The best way to judge Planned Parenthood is by comparing its rhetoric to its record. Any neutral observer can find a pattern of deception:

- Planned Parenthood claims to be pro-family but it routinely violates the natural right of parents to guide the health and welfare of their children and to protect those children from criminal exploitation.
- Planned Parenthood claims to be pro-child but it kills more children than any plague or tyrant.
- Planned Parenthood claims to be “pro-choice” but it has successfully sued to prevent a state from giving financial support to organizations that offer choices to mothers with difficult pregnancies. This is because Planned Parenthood makes money only when mothers have abortions, not when they have choices.
- Planned Parenthood claims to be pro-woman, but it has gone to court to take away from women the right to be informed about the nature of abortion and the right to take time to reflect on their own life-or-death decision.
- Planned Parenthood claims it represents the views of most Americans but it has successfully sued the State of Missouri to force it to give taxpayer money to Planned Parenthood when the elected representatives of the people decided against doing so.
- Planned Parenthood claims to be a voice for minority populations but the methods created by eugenics advocate and Planned Parenthood founder Margaret Sanger to destroy minorities

are the same ones employed by Planned Parenthood today to “help” these people. The sad reality is that Planned Parenthood has killed more minority human beings than the Ku Klux Klan could ever have hoped of lynching.

- Planned Parenthood even claims to be pro-freedom but it has given awards to the criminals who manage Communist China’s forced abortion program and has demanded that American taxpayers subsidize that horrific cruelty.

This comparison of rhetoric to reality shows that the bumper sticker which reads, “Pro-Family, Pro-Child, Pro-Choice” is like one which would read, “Pro-Peace, Pro-Humanity, Pro-Nuclear Holocaust.” All of the slick slogans and double-speak in the world will not change the facts.

It should not surprise us that Planned Parenthood lies in its advertising slogans because it unabashedly misleads the public in pushing its political agenda. For example, the medical director of Planned Parenthood’s Washington, D.C., affiliate put in writing the false claim that during a partial-birth abortion babies are not killed by the abortionist who stabs them, but by the anesthesia administered to their mothers. This untruth, deliberately circulated by a person who, remarkably enough, still holds a license to practice medicine, caused such fear among pregnant mothers that the American College of Anesthesiologists asked Congress to hold a special hearing to refute this dangerous lie.

Planned Parenthood is not about choices or truth. It is about building a financial empire and expanding a culture of death to the whole world. It is no less than a battle between good and evil; between God and the author of lies and death.
